Business forum with a delegation of businessmen from Çorlu, Turkey

On Monday, June 8, 2015 at the Ministry of Industry and Trade held a business forum with a delegation of businessmen from the town of Çorlu, which together with the Ministry organized the Confederation of Industry of the Czech Republic and CzechTrade. In the first part of the forum spoke director of Department of International Relations Confederation psůmyslu and Transport, Mr. Luke Martin, Commercial Counselor of the Embassy of the Republic of Turkey in Prague, Mr. Necmi Uğurlu, president of the Association of Entrepreneurs and producers Corlu, Mr. Celal Öğücü, representative of CzechInvest, Mr. Andrew Štec, CzechTrade representative, Mr. Michal Nedělka, a representative of the Ministry of industry and trade, Mr. Jan Poličanský. This was followed by meetings Czech and Turkish businessmen, attended by representatives of the Chamber.

A delegation of the Association of Entrepreneurs and producers Corlu (Çorlu İş İnsanları in Sanayicileri Derneği) led by its Chairman, Mr. Celal Öğücü. The association was founded in 2002 and currently has more than 50 members. Çorlu lies in Tekirdag province in eastern Thrace near the main road linking Istanbul with Bulgaria and Greece. There is also a free trade zone, which among other things operates Foxconn.
